





all those subjects spanned 70 years. This year's theme was the number 12. The many presentations on this theme kept the audience spell-bound by day, and a super cast of magicians entertained by night. We're still testing whether working smarter, harder and longer will let us at least keep breaking even. After 37 years of doing this, our best reward is still the creative process and meeting customers who value what we do.




